## PROCLAMATION FOR OCTOBER 2009 TO BE CYBER SECURITY AWARENESS MONTH IN THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO

**WHEREAS**, the County of Sacramento is increasingly reliant on the Internet to bring government services and information to constituents, employees, businesses, and other organizations; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has been nationally recognized for its e-government efforts, and has won numerous awards, including second place in the National Association of Counties 2009 Annual Digital Counties Survey; and

**WHEREAS**, Internet users and the County's information infrastructure face an increasing threat of malicious cyber attack, loss of privacy from spyware and adware and significant financial and personal privacy losses due to identity theft and fraud; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Sacramento is the California local government representative in the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center (MS-ISAC) which provides a collaborative mechanism to help states and local governments enhance cyber security; and the County of Sacramento's Office of Communications and Information Technology provides a comprehensive approach to help enhance the security of this County; and

**WHEREAS**, maintaining the security of cyberspace is a shared responsibility in which each of us has a critical role, and awareness of computer security essentials will improve the security of the County of Sacramento's information infrastructure and economy; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security ([www.us-cert.gov](http://www.us-cert.gov)), the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center ([www.msisac.org](http://www.msisac.org)), the National Cyber Security Alliance ([www.staysafeonline.org](http://www.staysafeonline.org)) and the National Association of State Chief Information Officers, ([www.nascio.org](http://www.nascio.org)), State of California Office of Information Security (<http://www.cio.ca.gov/OIS/>), have declared October as National Cyber Security Awareness Month; and all citizens are encouraged to visit these sites to learn about cyber security and put that knowledge into practice in their homes, schools, workplaces, and businesses.
